**Isaiah 42:1-2** "Behold, My Servant, whom I uphold; My chosen one *in whom* My soul delights. I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the nations. <sup>2</sup> "He will not cry out or raise *His voice*, Nor make His voice heard in the street.

**Isaiah 49:3** <sup>3</sup> He said to Me, "You are My Servant, Israel, In Whom I will show My glory."

**Isaiah 49:5** <sup>5</sup> And now says the LORD, who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant, To bring Jacob back to Him, so that Israel might be gathered to Him (For I am honored in the sight of the LORD, And My God is My strength),

**Isaiah 49:6** <sup>6</sup> He says, "It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob

**Isaiah 49:7** Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel *and* its Holy One, To the despised One, To the One abhorred by the nation, To the Servant of rulers,

**Isaiah 50:10** <sup>10</sup> Who is among you that fears the LORD, That obeys the voice of His servant,

**Isaiah 52:13** <sup>13</sup> Behold, My servant will prosper, He will be high and lifted up and greatly exalted.

**Isaiah 53:11** By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities.

**Isaiah 45:13** <sup>13</sup> "I have aroused him in righteousness And I will make all his ways smooth; He will build My city and will let My exiles go free, Without any payment or reward," says the LORD of hosts.

**Isaiah 46:11** <sup>11</sup> Calling a bird of prey from the east, The man of My purpose from a far country. Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass. I have planned *it, surely* I will do it.

**Isaiah 48:14** <sup>14</sup> "Assemble, all of you, and listen! Who among them has declared these things? The LORD loves him; he will carry out His good pleasure on Babylon, And His arm *will be against* the Chaldeans.
